Thematic Essay Questions

Following are the essay questions that comprise the brief theme including the essay question students need to write within 850-1000 words. Please read the themes stated or depicted very carefully and write an essay as asked. The students are requested to read the following guidelines before they proceed. Students are supposed to write an essay in ANY ONE of the question of their choice and ease.

Guidelines for Students:

- Students should select **ANY ONE** of the essay topic as per their ease.
- The first paragraph of the question states the theme the students need to concentrate.
- The essay should compulsorily be **handwritten** in a paper of normal long notebook **with lines**.
- The total duration to **write and upload** the essay for students is of **3 hrs**.
- Students must write their **name, exam roll number** and **email ID** on each page of their respective answer sheets.
- After the completion, students need to **upload** the answer sheets, using the email of the respective colleges where they have applied.
- Answer sheets should be uploaded in **jpg** or **pdf** format with their **respective name** as a file name (E.g. *sunil_thapa.jpg* or *sunil_thapa.pdf*)
- Essay will be evaluated on the basis of **content, narrations (descriptions), grammar, structure and logical conclusions** they have included in the essay.
- The essay is of **25 marks**.
- Students must write the theme they have chosen at the **Top of the Page**.

Question 1:

Essay Theme: 'PETA' and Ethical Treatment

PETA (People for Ethical Treatment of Animals) is an organization of animal rightists who resist against the anthropomorphic (*described or thought of as having human form or attributes*) use of animals in fashion and utility and advocate for ethical treatment of animals for human consumption. However, their continuous resistance is not making much difference on the way human think of animals and behave to them. Since ages, humans have been consuming animals for various purposes. So this is one of the most debatable topics. What is your take on this issue? Justify your claim with strong arguments.

In this context, write an essay in 850-1000 words that actualize this maxim and explain in which ways PETA will be capable of instilling ethical treatment for animals all over the world. Focus your discussion on how you suggest PETA for devising equal and ethical treatment to animals.

Question 2:

Essay Theme: Violence Against Women (VAW)

One of the major human rights violations that is globally alarming and is much more concerned is Violence Against Women. Globally 1 in 3 women experience physical and/or sexual violence in their lifetime. Particularly intimate partner violence and sexual violence are two major forms of violation of women's human rights. It is often rooted in several communities and societies and perpetuates gender inequalities.

In this context, write an essay on VAW (Violence against Women) in 850-1000 words that actualize this maxim. Your paragraphs should concentrate on analyzing the causes of violence and its impacts upon status of Nepalese women. Settle the write up with prognostic (analytical) outcome of the discussion.

Question 3:

Essay Theme: Industrialization and Its Impact

Globally, industrialization has had positive and negative impacts on the lives of workers and people around the globe. Social activist and economist to some extent consider heavy industrialization as one of the major causes of economic and social differences. It is also attributed for environmental degradation that might be resulting to the spread of pandemics like COVID-19 and etc.

Write an essay within 850-1000 words incorporating your thoughts in the above mentioned theme. Discuss specific examples of the ways in which industrialization have changed the lives of workers and people around the globe and its impact. Discuss the response of the, social activists, reformers, and/or government to these changes.
