Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Development Studies

(Date of Application Announcement: 11 August 2022)

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission into the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Development Studies programme for 2022 session offered by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Pokhara University, Nepal. The PhD programme aims to produce expert and specialized high-level human resources for teaching, research and professional expert services. The programme seeks candidates with strong academic background, who are highly motivated and have curiosity and desire for intellectual excellence.

About the Programme: The programme comprises of 24 credits of extensive coursework (Philosophy, Research Methodology, Academic Writing and Seminar Skills, Core Courses, Elective Courses, Independent Study) structured in two semesters. After successfully completing the coursework with a minimum CGPA of 3.3, the scholar can register 36 credits dissertation for PhD degree. If a student is unable to complete the doctoral proposal within the given duration or cannot secure a minimum CGPA of 3.3 in the coursework or choses to apply for MPhil Degree, the completed credits of the coursework can be transferred to an MPhil degree. The student shall register 9 credits dissertation and pursue MPhil degree. The normal duration of the PhD programme is 3 to 5 years with a total of 60 credits.

Eligibility: A master degree in any field from Pokhara University or any other recognized university along with the following specific qualifications:

- [i] Two years of work experience for those who have passed Master Level with 3.00/4.00 CGPA or high Second Division (55%);
- [ii] One year of work experience for those who have passed Master Level with 3.30/4.00 CGPA or First Division;
- [iii] There will be no requirement of working experience for those who have passed Master Level with 3.75/4.00 CGPA or Distinction Division.

Admission Process: Admission to the PhD in Development Studies programme will be on merit basis based on total score (200) obtained from:

- [i] Entrance test (100): Entrance test will be based on MCQ comprising of modules Quantitative ability (20), Logical reasoning (20), English proficiency (20), Conceptual knowledge of Development Studies (20), and Research aptitude (20)
 [ii] Interview (30)
- [iii] Statement of purpose (5) and Research synopsis (10)
- [iv] Academic achievement (40)

[v] Research publication (10) and work experience (5)
