Nepal adopted the multi-university concept in 1983. The idea of Pokhara University (PU) was conceived in 1986. However, it was established only in 1997 under the Pokhara University Act, 1997. The Incumbent Honorable Prime Minister and the Honorable Minister for Education of the Federal Democratic Republic of Nepal are the Chancellor and the Pro-Chancellor of the University respectively.

More than 34 thousand students are currently registered in Pokhara University. They appear in the final examination according to semester system except MBA and BSc. Nursing Programs which follow Trimester system and annual system respectively.



## Pokhara University Research Center

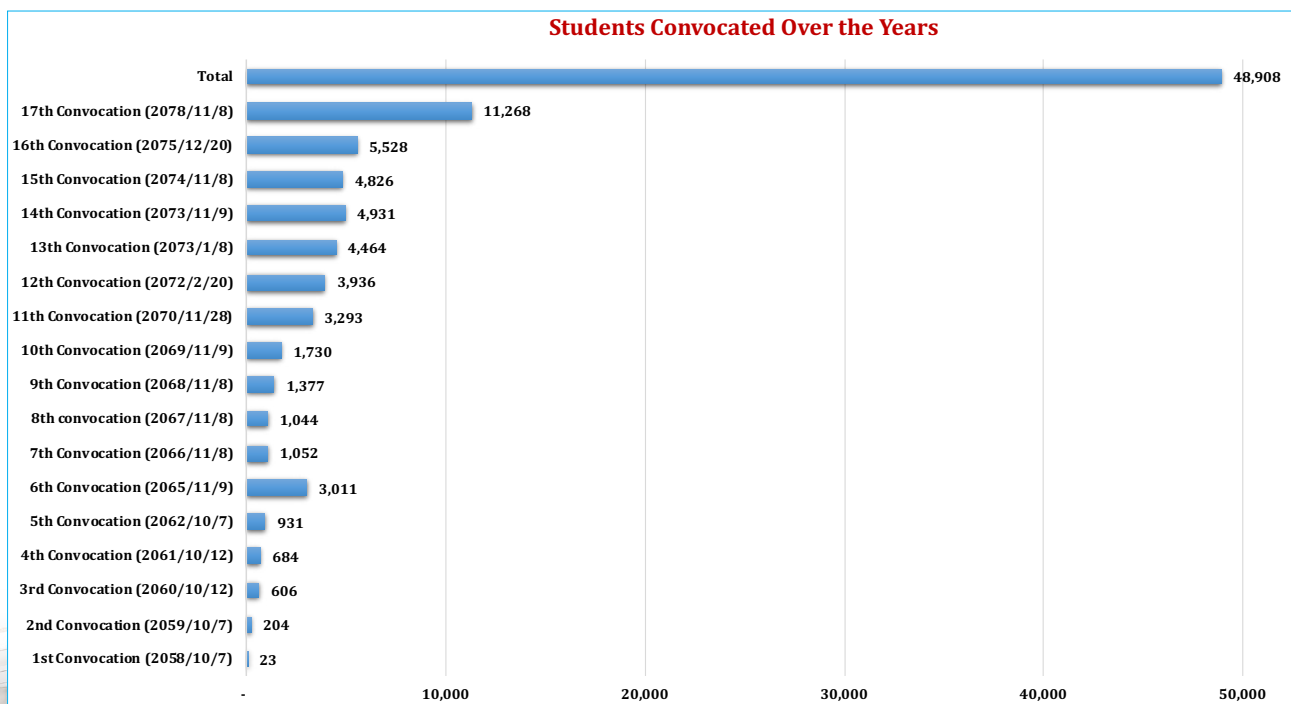

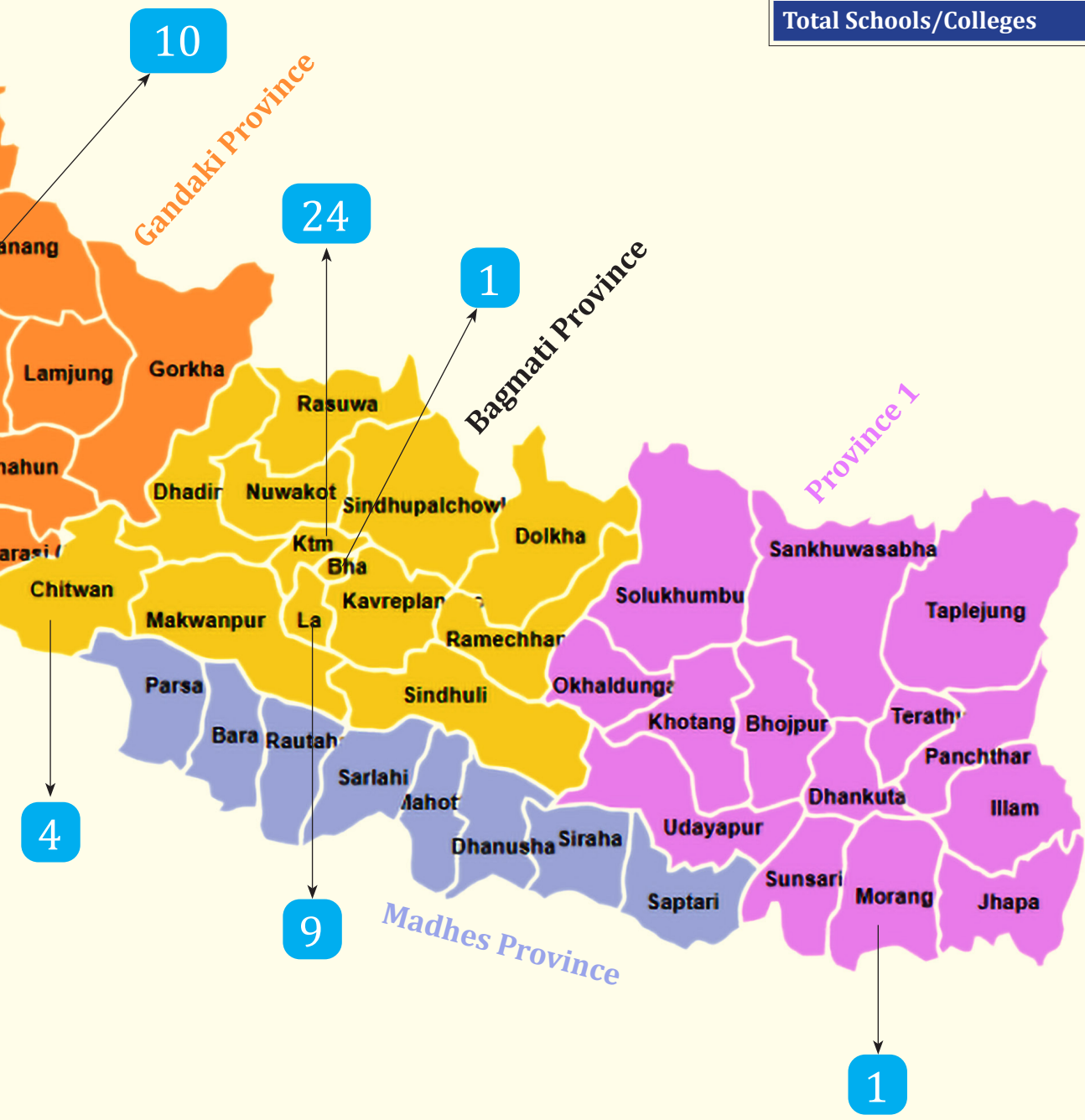
