Curriculum Outline of Entrance Examination of B.A.LL.B. Programme

Every student applying for admission to the Bachelor of Arts Bachelor of Laws (B.A.LL.B.) programme at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Pokhara University must pass the entrance examination. The entrance examination is designed to assess students' ability to study the B.A.LL.B. programme at Pokhara University.

The entrance examination comprises five major areas that include English Language Proficiency (Grammar, Vocabulary, Reading Comprehension/Passage) (30 marks), Logical Reasoning (30 marks), Basic Knowledge of Law (Constitution, Jurisprudence, Civil Law, Criminal Law, Environmental Law, Family Law, etc.) (30 marks), Basic Knowledge of Liberal Arts (Sociology, Economics, Political Sciences) (30 marks), General Knowledge (30 marks).

The full marks for the entrance exam is 150. A student must obtain at least 40 per cent to pass the entrance examination. All the questions will be Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). Each right answer will carry 1 mark. No negative marking for the incorrect answer.

The total time for the entrance examination will be three hours. A candidate who has passed the entrance examination is eligible for admission on the merit basis of marks obtained in the entrance examination.
